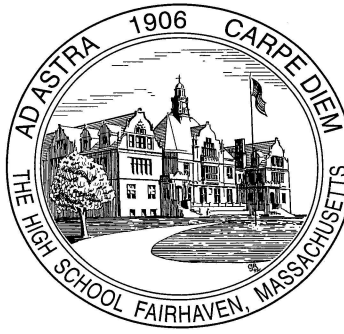

Dear Parent/Guardian

We are pleased to announce that the **Fairhaven High School Junior/Senior Prom** will be held on Friday, May 12th, 2017 from 6:00-11:00 PM. This year's prom will be held at the Venus De Milo in Swansea. This letter is to inform you of several key dates and information that must be followed to make this a successful night for all involved.

- Prom tickets will be **\$55.00**. Checks can be made out to Fairhaven High School.
- Prom tickets will go on sale **Monday, April 24th and continue through Friday, April 28th**. Tickets can be purchased before school **in the large cafeteria from 7:00-7:20 AM**. Tickets may also be purchased Monday thru Friday after school in the **small cafeteria from 2:10-2:30 PM**. ***These are the only times that tickets may be purchased.***
- **All class dues must be paid in full before tickets can be purchased.** Class dues must be paid to your class advisor ***either before or after school only.***
 - **Seniors** – Davis/Kelley
 - **Juniors** – Pilla/Pilla
 - **Sophomores** – Boucher/Vernacchio
 - **Freshmen** – Dollard/Iriarte
- **No seats will be saved or reserved without payment for tickets, class dues, and approval of guest forms by administration.** Once you have chosen your seats there will be no changes.
- The only transportation permitted for the prom is via the coach buses hired by the school. Students need to be at the school by 5:15 p.m. All students going to prom must be on their assigned bus at that time. Bus assignments will be available in homeroom the week prior to prom. **All students are required to be in school the day of prom.** May 12th is an early release day at 11:10.
- All students, in accordance with FHS protocol, will be subject to a **breathalyzer test**. Any student failing the test will be removed from the prom and parents will be notified and will be responsible for picking up their child.
- Any student bringing a guest who does not attend FHS will be required to have a **guest form** signed by their parent. Guest forms are now available in the main office and at the reception desk. All guests must be under the age of 21. Freshmen and sophomore guests must be approved by Ms. Muello or Mr. Kulak. Guest forms must be approved by Ms. Muello or Mr. Kulak before purchasing prom tickets. All guests who do not attend FHS must attach a copy of their license and/or photo ID to the guest form. Students are responsible for their guest and can be subject to disciplinary action if school rules are violated.
- Shoes and appropriate dress are required at all times during the prom. If students are planning to take off their shoes, flip-flops or sandals are acceptable.
- **After Prom Event** – If you are planning on attending the After Prom, you must register by Tuesday May 9th.
