The professional vacancy process for the Athletic Director vacancy was posted in the Neighborhood News from June 14, 2018-June 20, 2018, the The Standard Times from June 13, 2018-June 22, 2018, and on SchoolSpring from June 12, 2018-June 26, 2018. The search team membership consisted of district administrators, building administrators, teacher-coaches, faculty, parents, and student athletes.

The timeline for this professional vacancy process began with the application deadline of June 27, 2018. The district received thirty (30) applications for the position. The paper screening of applications concluded and seventeen (17) candidates were selected to interview during the initial interview phase of the process. The initial interviews were conducted between July 5, and July 10, 2018. A total of six (6) candidates were selected for interviews during the panel portion of the process at Fairhaven High School between July 14, and July 20, 2018.

The Fairhaven Public Schools is proud to announce the hiring of Christopher Carrig for the position of Athletic Director. Mr. Carrig received his Masters of Education from Endicott College in Athletic Administration. He is a double major who received his Bachelor of Science in Biology and his Bachelor of Arts is in Chemistry from Roger Williams University.

Mr. Carrig currently serves as the Assistant Athletic Director at Bishop Stang High School. He has been a teacher/coach at Bishop Stang since 2009. He has served as the Head Coach of the Men's Club Lacrosse team at Roger Williams University since 2014. Mr. Carrig is a Certified Athletic Administrator and has certifications in HeadsUp through USA Football and as a Level 2 coach through USA Lacrosse.

The entire process has shown Mr. Carrig to be an extremely professional candidate with a passion for the overall development of the student-athlete. His former athletic director Ryan Sylvia stated that, "he is a tireless worker with attention to every detail."
