PERIOD THREE: WHAT ARE MY CHANCES?

WHAT YOU'LL need: TWO COINS, PAPER, AND PENCIL TO KEEP SCORE

WHAT TO DO

1. **FLIP ONE COIN. EVERY TIME IT COMES UP HEADS, YOUR CHILD GETS 1 POINT. EVERY TIME IT COMES UP TAILS, YOU GET 1 POINT. FLIP IT 50 TIMES. TALLY BY 5'S TO MAKE IT EASIER TO KEEP TRACK OF SCORES. THE PERSON WITH THE MOST POINTS WINS. WHO WON? WAS THIS GAME FAIR?**



2. **FLIP TWO COINS. IF THE COINS COME UP TWO TAILS OR TWO HEADS, YOUR CHILD SCORES 1 POINT. IF IT COMES UP HEADS AND TAILS, YOU GET 1 POINT. AFTER 50 FLIPS, SEE WHO HAS MORE POINTS. DO YOU THINK THE GAME IS FAIR? WHAT IF ONE PERSON RECEIVED 2 POINTS FOR EVERY DOUBLE HEADS AND THE OTHER PERSON RECEIVED 1 POINT FOR EVERYTHING ELSE. IS THIS FAIR?**

COMPARING PRICES

Set Up a Store at Home

What you'll need: Grocery objects (cans, cartons or boxes), calculator, pencil, and paper

What to do

- 1. Collect grocery objects as if you were shopping at the grocery store. Gather the items and put them on a table.**
- 2. Think of a price for each item. Mark the prices on the containers. You can even mark some items on sale.**
- 3. Have someone be the customer while you are the cashier. Switch roles.**
- 4. Add the prices of each item on the calculator and total the amount using the (=) symbol. Write the total(s) on a piece of paper, which will be your receipt. Take a picture and post to Google Classroom.**
- 5. Challenge: How much would it cost to buy three cartons of one of your items? How much does 1 box of soap cost, if they are 2 for \$5.00? How much is my bill, if I don't buy the cereal? How much more will it cost if I buy this magazine? Estimate the amounts of the items you are buying. Check to see if the estimation is correct on the calculator.**

STATES OF MATTER

Extension in Study of Matter! Make your own ice cream

Items needed: a container with a lid, ice, 6 tablespoons of rock salt, ½ cup of half and half, 1 tablespoon of granulated sugar, ½ teaspoon of vanilla extract and 2 ziploc bags.

Step 1: fill the container about halfway with ice.

Step 2: add 6 tablespoons of rock salt to the ice.

Step 3: make sure the lid is on tightly, now shake the ice and rock salt in the container for about 5 minutes. You might want to wear gloves because the container will get very cold. (the ice and rock salt will get to around 14°F)

Step 4: in the zipper bag add the ½ cup of half and half, 1 tablespoon of granulated sugar, and ½ teaspoon of vanilla extract.

Step 5: be sure to press out as much air from the bag before closing it. You will take the bag with the mixture and place it into the second zipper bag again pressing out the air before closing.

Step 6: place the double bagged mixture into the container of ice and rock salt and replace the lid.

Step 7: Now shake, rock, and roll your container to make some yummy ice cream. (this should take 15 to 20 minutes, when ice cream reaches desired firmness it is ready to eat!)
