I understand that this <i>Affidavit</i> will be relied upon by the Fairhaven Public Schools for the purpose of determining the above student's eligibility to attend the Fairhaven Public Schools on the basis of residency. If said student is enrolled in the Fairhaven Public Schools based upon the information provided and it is subsequently determined that the student does not actually reside in Fairhaven, <i>I</i> understand that the student's enrollment in the Fairhaven Public Schools will be promptly terminated and <i>I</i> will be jointly and severally liable to the Fairhaven Public Schools for the student's tuition for the full academic year(s).
6.	I understand that all students must reside in the Town of Fairhaven (Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 76, sec 5 every person shall have a right to attend the public schools of the town where he/she actually resides, subject to the following section. No School Committee is required to enroll a person who does not actually reside in the town unless said enrollment is authorized by law or by the School Committee. Any person who violates or assists in the violation of this provision may be required to remit full restitution to the town of the improperly-attended public schools.
