

ADMINISTERING MEDICINES TO STUDENTS

Medication may not be administered to students while at school unless such medicine is given to them by the school nurse acting under specific written request of the parent or guardian and under the written directive of the student's personal physician. When the school nurse is not present, another nurse will cover and administer the medication as ordered. No one but the school nurse, and those others listed in the medical administration plan acting within the above restriction, may give any medication to any student.
