

STUDENT GIFTS AND SOLICITATIONS

The Fairhaven Public Schools has direct, daily, live contact with more homes in the community than any other institution or organization. Because of this unique position, there is a tendency to look to the school organization as a means of communication to students and other members of the families of the community. To prevent any misuse of the school organization, the following guidelines have been established:

1. Students and the school organization shall not be used as a means of collecting information not directly pertinent to the conduct of the school program.
2. Solicitation of funds for charitable purposes from students of the school system will be made only as approved by the building principal.
3. Any organization desiring to distribute flyers or other materials to students in connection with fund drives may do so only with the approval of the Superintendent.
